APPELLATION

Côtes-du-Rhône

SURFACE

69 ha (160 acres)

ASPECT

South-West

AVERAGE AGE OF VINEYARD

60 years old

PRODUCTION

Around 50.000 bottles (4.200 cases)

SOIL

Similar to that of the neighbouring Châteauneuf-du-Pape vineyard, consisting of pudding stones on the surface, which store the heat from the sun during the day and transfer it to the vines at night. Red clay in the subsoil.

GRAPE VARIETIES

• 50 % Grenache • 20 % Syrah • 10 % Carignan • 20 % Cinsault

VINIFICATION / AGING

Half of the blend is obtained by pressing the grapes directly, as soon as they arrive at the winery; the other half by drawing off juice from the vat (saignée) after 24 hours of maceration.

CHARACTER

Intensely-coloured. The nose is dominated by red fruit, particularly raspberry. The palate is rich and well-balanced. Potential of aging: 5 to 8 years

ACCOMPANIMENT

A wine to be drunk young and fresh; a very good accompaniment for summer salads, charcuterie and grilled food.
